HOME-BASED LEARNING



Student Responsibilities

Set up a learning space.

Be prepared each day for learning.

Attend each lessons as per your normal timetable structure. Establish a routine for learning.

Collaborate with your class members at appropriate times in appropriate ways.

If you are unable to meet a deadline or require assistance ask your teacher for help early.

Engage daily in: physical activity, mindfulness and connectivity activities.

Commit to doing your best.

FOR ONLINE LEARNING

Check in with you RAS teacher each day before 9.30am to be marked present.

If involved in video conferencing – wear your school uniform and use a quiet, uninterrupted space.

Adhere to school rules in regards to Respect, Responsibility and Safety in the online environment.

Check in at least once a week and communicate with teachers through appropriate learning and communication platforms: Class Notebook, school email.

FOR PAPER-BASED LEARNING

Complete set work for the week and return to the school each Friday for checking.

Ensure you have had contact with your teacher at least once a week via telephone (Ph: 41 300222 and ask for your teacher to contact you).

Tips for Parents

Plan with your student about what they will be learning.

Have a consistent routine each day and expectations of your child.

Set aside a learning space for your child to work in.

Monitor communications from your child's teachers and the school.

Support teachers by monitoring your student's completion of daily and weekly tasks.

Encourage daily; physical activity, mindfulness and connectivity with others.

Remember to use respectful communication.

Ensure the school has your current contact details.

Contact the school office on 41 300 222 if you have any queries/concerns.

Contact the school using usual processes to indicate if your child is unable to engage in learning due to eg illness on a day.

FOR ONLINE LEARNING

Check your emails – teachers will be emailing you and your child the weekly schedule for each subject.

Monitor your students online behaviour and where possible limit screen time for non-curriculum activities.

Check that your child has emailed their RAS teacher by 9.30 am each day to indicate they are engaged in learning and will be marked present for the attendance roll.

FOR PAPER-BASED LEARNING

Parents should contact the school via telephone every day to indicate their child is engaged in learning and be marked present for the attendance roll.
