Bundaberg North State High School will receive**

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Year 12 students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) from 78% in 2014 to 90% in 2015.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 83% and Mathematics from 91% in Year 8 (2014) to 95% in Year 9 (2015) for English and Mathematics in 2015.
- Achieve 95% of Year 7 and 8 students achieving above a C standard in Mathematics and English.
- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an individual curriculum plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.
- Increase the percentage of students in Years 7 and 9 in the NAPLAN upper two bands (U2B) by 10 % across all strands of the test compared to the 2013 Year 5 and 7 performance.
- Increase the percentage of students in Years 7 and 9 above National Minimum Standard across all strands of the test by 15% compared to the 2013 Years 5 and 7 performance.

Our strategy will be to

- Build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices to cater for individual student learning needs.
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension across all learning areas.
- Continue to develop the concept of a guaranteed and viable curriculum to ensure the school's literacy and numeracy curriculum can be delivered to all students.
- Implement the concept of faculty professional learning communities based on the "Dufour" model to support the continued implementation of the schools Literacy and Numeracy curriculum and improvement.
- Continue to maintain staff in the roles of Literacy, Numeracy and Instructional Coaches to build capability in Instruction, Literacy and Numeracy teaching and learning skills.
- Continue to implement a researched based Teaching and Learning Framework based on the Art and Science of Teaching.
- Embed the culture, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to encourage reflective practice/action learning.
- Build the capacity of the Senior Leadership team to provide professional coaching support to all staff.
- Facilitate action learning/ research with the support of the Master Teacher to identify and verify the effectiveness of strategies currently in use.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards. Develop teacher capacity to design curriculum-aligned monitoring and assessment tasks (for short-term data cycles).

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- Increase the skills of teacher aides to support the consolidation of student learning in numeracy and literacy.
- Continue to build the Northern Alliance Cluster Literacy and Numeracy strategy; Bridging the Gap and evaluate its impact on student learning.
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve Literacy and Numeracy learning.
