This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a A-C standard across the school.
- Focus on lifting Year 7&8 English and Mathematics results 40% A-B outcomes.
- Maintain the percentage of Year 12 students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement QCIA at the 95-100% attainment rate and continue implementation of the new QCE system for all year 11 and 12 students.
- Reduce number of Student Disciplinary Absences (SDAs) across school with implementation of new North Support Structure.
- Focus on reducing disengagement in junior school implementing the Year 8 FlexiSpace program, engaging GOSEW and other external agencies.
- Support students to transition to successful pathways post school.

Our initiatives include

- A school wide focus on Achievement, Consistency and Clarity and Quality Assurance (aligning with AIP).
- Continuation of Intentional Curriculum Collaboration (ICC) time for staff each week to implement school wide quality assurance processes discussing curriculum programs, pedagogy, differentiation and data using moderation processes.
- Introduce Learning Walks in Year 7 & 8 English and Mathematics classes.
- Using ICC time to build teacher capacity in curriculum planning, delivery and moderation.
- Development and implementation of a new North Support Structure to improve student wellbeing, attendance and behaviour.
- Complete co-design model for First Nations student support developing and engaging a Local Community Education Body to inform Principal and to strengthen community partnerships, and focus on developing strategies to support First Nations students' to improve retention, attendance and successful completion of schooling through targeted programs.
- Continue development of Parent Liaison Officer role to increase parent engagement and satisfaction.
